



Spanish Lake Elementary Uniform Policy

The parents and community of Spanish Lake Elementary School have elected and adopted a mandatory school uniform policy. It consists of red embroidered polo tops and khaki bottoms: pants, Bermuda shorts, skirts to the knees (girls). No cargo shorts or cargo pants are permitted. Closed shoes, preferably with thick soles (such as sneakers) are accepted. No open-toed shoes are allowed for safety purposes. Please ask the main office for the location where you may purchase and obtain school uniforms. On Fridays, school spirit day, students may wear Spanish Lake Explorers spirit t-shirts. You may purchase these t-shirts from the PTA. Spirit t-shirts are to be worn with uniform bottoms.

No shoes that are higher than ankle height are to be used. Sneakers are highly recommended at all times. Leggings or tights can be used under skirts or pants only under 50 degree weather. Skirts are to be no shorter than and 1 to 2 inches above the knee. Each child should have a belt and maintain their shirts tucked in to maintain a clean and proper appearance. Neat and appropriate hair styles are recommended, dress for success!

Silly Bands or rubber bands are not allowed for safety reason & may cause disruption in learning & instructional process.

Heelys or roller skating sneakers or any kind are not allowed due to safety reason.
